1. An official entry form completed and signed.
2. A brief CV (of each artist) for promotional purposes, including your photograph.
3. The concept design of your sculpture.
4. Please include a description of your intended work in 150 words or less.

TERMS & CONDITIONS – Themed category

1. As part of the NZ Mural Contest & Arts Festival, taking place from September 28 – October 5, 2019, Katikati Open-Air Art Inc. has organised the Sculpture Competition 2019.
2. Katikati Open-Air Art Inc. is looking to add to its collection of sculptures in Katikati. The theme for the competition is **LIFE IS NOT WHAT IT SEEMS** and artists are to interpret this theme for their entry.
3. The winning sculptor will have the honor of having their work permanently displayed in Katikati, in addition to receiving a **CASH PRIZE of \$4,000**.
4. Application for entry close 01 May 2019.
5. Successful applicants will be notified 13 May 2019.
6. Katikati Open-Air Art will make every effort to ensure the safety of the sculptures but will not be liable for any loss or damage incurred.
7. For safety reasons we ask that there be no sheet lead used and no dangerously sharp edges.
8. There is no size restriction but entries must be able to be easily moved by two people for storage overnight and sufficiently robust for such moving without breaking. Entries not able to be moved will be left outside on display at the owner's risk. Some security may be provided.
9. The judge's decision is final and no correspondence will be entered into.
10. Entries to be dropped off to the designated area prior to the commencement of the NZ Mural Contest and Arts Festival for public outdoor display and judging.
11. Entries should have the sculptor's name, address and phone number firmly attached, as well as whether the piece is for sale and the price inclusive of 25% commission.
12. Sculptures not sold should be collected on completion of the festival from the designated area.
13. Submission of an entry into the contest automatically constitutes the artist's acceptance of all competition terms and conditions.
14. The winning sculpture will become the property of Katikati Open-Air Art after payment of the cash prize.
